POLICY:

Tennessee Valley Electric Cooperative will charge a \$50.00 (fifty dollar) service charge to each consumer whose meter is removed due to high water. This charge will be added to the consumer's bill when the meter is reset.

The reason for this charge is the high cost of service that is borne by TVEC to serve customers in areas subject to flooding.

The service charge will be charged regardless of whether the meter is damaged or not.
